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1. General Remarks:

- When students arrive school in the morning, they can come out of classrooms, benches are only for sitting: no eating & drinking.
- Class Teacher Period (Deliver Homework, Check Handbook, Distribute Notices). At **12:45p.m.**, doors will open for dismissal.
- During Recess, students should take rest in classrooms. Students may go to the playground only with teacher's permission.
- Toilet break: Teachers will allow students to go toilet when necessary (e.g. 10 minutes before lesson ends).

2. Assembly

- Our weekly assembly will be held every week online by Principal Ho and other members of staff to maintain proper distancing and eliminate mass gathering.

3. Proper Use of Masks

- Students **MUST** wear mask while taking school bus and in school campus at all times.
- Students are advised to keep an extra mask in their school bag, students must replace mask if it is damaged or dirty.
- Students are reminded to refrain from talking when their masks are taken off and should not touch their masks and eyes with their hands.
- Masks must be wrapped properly before disposing into rubbish bin.

4. Recess

- Students should wear masks during recess time, and should keep a proper social distance with other students.
- Parents can pack snacks and water for child/ward to school every day, it is advised that snacks are individually packed.
- Students should allow proper physical distancing when having snacks and should not share food, tableware and drinks with classmates. Student should put their masks back on immediately after finishing snacks.
- Water Fountain will not be used for hygiene purposes, please ensure that student have enough packed water.

5. Monitoring Body Temperature & Proper Hygiene

- Parents are required to check your child/ward body temperature before returning to schools.
- Please note that temperature record sheets must be signed by parents and bring back to school for teachers to check every day.
- If students have fever, cough, sore throat and or respiratory symptoms, students wear masks and should not return to school and seek medical advice immediately.
- Students should avoid sharing stationeries and books to maintain proper distancing among classmates.
- Hand hygiene should be performed properly before touching eyes, mouth, before eating. Washing hands for more than 20 seconds should be maintained as a proper hygiene habit.

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6. **First day back to school**

- Students will be given 10 packed masks provided by Principal Ho and 1 CU mask (銅芯口罩) by the Government.
- Students must bring the **'Declaration form for travel history and health status of students'** and submit to teachers on their first day of school. (Attachment: Proforma B)
- Students must bring and present the signed **temperature record sheet** every day at the school gate. (Attachment: Proforma A)
